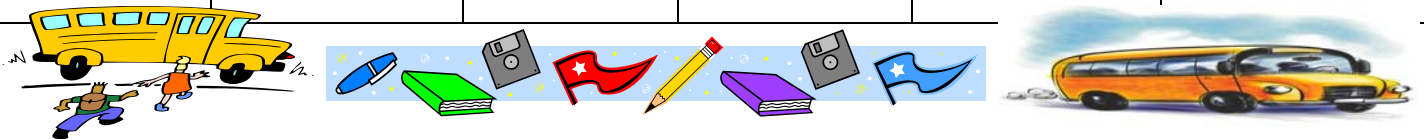
# **FALL BOOKMOBILE ROUTE**
