Answer: It's still in the system. Space that the file occupied is labeled as unused and the link to it has been removed from the directory structure. For the time being it is still in memory. However over time as you add or copy more files to your machine the old file will eventually become overwritten and permanently lost. But if given time with the proper file restoration program a file removed from the Bin can be dug up and used again.

## A few key points to remember when visiting Markham Public Library.

- If there are any books you would like to see in the library, fill out a book request form and submit it at the circulation desk.
- There is a year-round book sale. Hardcover books sell for 25 cents and paperback books are 10 cents.
- Make sure materials are returned in the same condition they were in when checked out.
- There is a maximum amount of six books that can be checked out at one time.
- You can always access your library record, pay fines and place holds via SWAN Online Catalog from home through our website.
